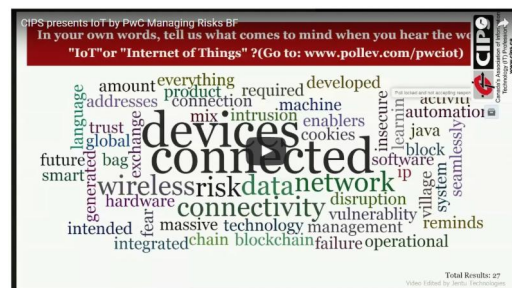


New CIPS Webcasts on "IoT" and "Technology Governance"
